

# PRIVACY POLICY

## 1. Introduction

Stryke Markets Ltd. (“**Stryke Markets**,” “**we**,” “**us**,” or “**our**”) is committed to protecting the privacy, confidentiality, and security of personal information entrusted to us by our clients and website users. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, disclose, and protect personal data in connection with our brokerage services, platform access, and related operations.

This Policy applies to all clients, prospective clients, and visitors who interact with Stryke Markets through our website, onboarding processes, trading platforms, communications, or related services.

By accessing our services or providing personal information to us, you acknowledge that you have read and understood this Privacy Policy.

## 2. Scope of This Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to:

- Users accessing our trading platforms or related systems
- Individuals communicating with us via email, forms, or other channels
- Visitors to our website or legal documentation pages

## 3. Information We Collect

We collect only the information necessary to operate our services in a secure, compliant, and professional manner.

### **3.1 Personal Information**

This may include, but is not limited to:

- Full name
- Date of birth
- Contact information (email address, phone number, mailing address)
- Government-issued identification (for identity verification)
- Proof of address
- Account identifiers and onboarding details

### **3.2 Financial and Trading Information**

- Trading account details
- Transaction history
- Funding and withdrawal records
- Performance and activity data generated through platform usage

### **3.3 Technical and Usage Information**

- IP address
- Device and browser information
- Login timestamps
- Platform usage metrics
- Cookies and basic analytics data

#### 4. How We Use Personal Information

We use personal information solely for legitimate business and compliance purposes, including:

- Verifying identity and onboarding clients
- Providing access to brokerage and trading services
- Processing transactions, deposits, and withdrawals
- Maintaining account security and fraud prevention
- Complying with legal, regulatory, and contractual obligations
- Improving platform functionality and operational efficiency
- Communicating service-related updates or notices

We do **not** sell, rent, or commercially exploit personal data.

#### 5. Legal Basis for Processing

Personal data is processed based on one or more of the following lawful bases:

- Performance of a contract (providing brokerage services)
- Compliance with legal or regulatory obligations
- Legitimate business interests (security, fraud prevention, platform integrity)
- Consent, where required by applicable law

#### 6. Data Sharing and Disclosure

Stryke Markets may share personal information **only as necessary** and **only with trusted parties**, including:

## 6.1 Service Providers and Partners

- Brokerage infrastructure providers
- Liquidity providers and execution venues (A-Book only)
- Identity verification and compliance vendors
- Payment processors and financial institutions
- Technology and platform service providers

All such parties are contractually required to safeguard data and use it only for authorized purposes.

## 6.2 Legal and Regulatory Disclosure

We may disclose personal information where required to:

- Comply with applicable laws or regulations
- Respond to lawful requests by authorities
- Protect the rights, property, or safety of Stryke Markets, its clients, or others

## 7. International Data Transfers

Stryke Markets operates internationally. Personal information may be processed or stored in jurisdictions outside the client's country of residence.

We take appropriate measures to ensure that international data transfers comply with applicable data protection laws and that personal data remains protected at all times.

## 8. Data Security

We implement administrative, technical, and organizational safeguards designed to protect personal information against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or disclosure.

These measures include:

- Secure systems and access controls
- Encryption where appropriate
- Limited internal access on a need-to-know basis
- Ongoing monitoring and risk management practices

While no system can guarantee absolute security, we maintain industry-standard protections aligned with professional financial services operations.

## **9. Data Retention**

Personal information is retained only for as long as necessary to:

- Fulfill contractual obligations

- Resolve disputes or enforce agreements

When data is no longer required, it is securely deleted or anonymized in accordance with our internal policies.
